

SEX OFFENDERS AGAINST MINORS POLICY
KENDALL YOUNG LIBRARY

- In accordance with Chapter 692A of Subtitle 1 of Title 16 of the Code of Iowa, the Board of Trustees prohibits the presence of sex offenders convicted of sex offenses against minors upon or within 300 feet of Kendall Young Library property at 1201 Willson Avenue, Webster City, Iowa.
- Violations of this policy will be immediately reported to law enforcement.
- Under the law, persons barred from library property remain entitled to library service. These individuals may apply for a library card with the assistance of a courier of their choice. A library card application form must be completed, and a proof of residence and an official state or federal identification number shown on a current driver's license or other official document must be provided.
- It is the responsibility of the barred library patron to arrange for an adult courier to select, check out, and return materials to the library through possession of the barred library patron's card. The barred library patron is responsible for all materials checked out on his/her library card.
- Persons barred from library property under the law will not be served by the Kendall Young Library home library service.
- The issuance of a library card to individuals who have been convicted of a sex offense involving a minor does not grant those individuals permission to enter the library or to be present on library property.
- Names will be checked using the National Sex Offender Registry for all employees, potential employees, and volunteers who are or will be working on Kendall Young Library property at 1201 Willson Avenue, Webster City, Iowa.
